

Notice of a Meeting of the Communications Committee of the Goring-on-Thames Parish Council

Prior to the start of the meeting, questions and comments from members of the public (limited to 10 minutes in total) NOTE: subject to all members expected to attend being present, this may start as early as 10:50

This provides an opportunity for members of the public (who are not usually permitted to speak during the meeting except by special invitation of the Chairman) to participate before the start of the meeting. Members of the public may make only one address to the council of no more than three minutes' duration and only concerning topics on the agenda. No decision can be taken during this session, but the Chairman may decide to refer any matters raised for further consideration.
