Relevant Extracts from the Burial Ground Regulations:

Fees are charged in accordance with the council's schedule applicable at the time of the burial or erection of a monument. Current fee scales can be viewed on the internet, at: www.goringparishcouncil.gov.uk. Residency qualification for charges for both interment and memorials are based upon the last permanent address of the deceased and not the exclusive rights owner. A maximum of 5 years limit applies when moving out of the home address for residential care etc.

Goring on Thames Parish Council will be responsible for the excavation of a coffin grave to the required depth and for backfilling immediately after the burial ceremony. The grave may be opened the day before the burial but must be left safely covered in accordance with current health and safety legislation. No work may be carried out whilst burials are taking place.
