**Parishes throughout England and Wales are required to hold an Annual Meeting of the Parish (APM) between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 1<sup>st</sup> June each year. Where there is a parish council, it is often the chairman of the council which convenes this meeting.**

### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the APM is to update the electors on all matters within the parish, not just the Parish Council, and provide a forum for registered electors to discuss anything they consider to be of importance to the people of the Parish.

### **WHO CAN ATTEND?**

This is a meeting for all the local government electors of the parish. This is NOT a meeting of the Parish Council. Anyone may attend, similarly to a Parish Council meeting, however only registered electors of the Civil Parish of Goring-on-Thames may vote.
