STATEMENT OF PLANS

In the gardening season covering summer 2024 to spring 2025, Goring on Thames in Bloom will carry out any weeding, trimming and removal of dead plants and shrubs that are necessary, as part of its on-going maintenance of the area. Dead plants or shrubs will be replaced with similar species to maintain the current design of the garden. The bed will be edged to keep it neat.

Goring on Thames in Bloom has no plans to make any changes to the garden, which is now mature since its inception in 2014.
