- 1 Chairman's welcome.

7 Annual report of the council see Appendix C

The Chairman summarised the annual report and advised the meeting that 7 nominations had been received for the Council in the forthcoming elections in May. Although there were a total of 13 places available he felt that this was too many and he would recommend that The Parish Council ask SODC to reduce the number to 10. He anticipated that the Council would consider dissolving the F&A and E&R Committees and holding Full Council meetings monthly. This would actually enable all the business previously conducted by F&A and E&R to be carried out more efficiently as these two committees only met every other month and sometimes had to refer matters to the Full Council. The Council would also be seeking to co-opt new Councillors in the coming year.

The chairman commended the annual report, which had been published in Goring Gap News in March 2011 and on the parish council's website.

Questions and concerns raised from the audience were:-

- (a) Traffic flows through the village and the impact the closure of Whitchurch Bridge will have on Goring.
- (b) Public Transport issues were also raised.
- (c) The closure of footpaths.

8 Reports from local organisations

David Boyd representing Goring and Streatley Amenity Association reported that the Association had carried a review of the Village Plan and he was pleased to report everything was holding up well.

Norman Radley proposed that a letter of congratulations should sent to Streatley PC on Their successful acquisition of "Gladedale Land". This was unanimously agreed.
