I had an email from the Chair of Goring Robins:



Following today's games, it has become evident that the parking area is becoming increasingly difficult to navigate, with reports of cars struggling to exit. This is likely to worsen as we move further into the winter months, and I am concerned it may eventually render the area unusable for parking.

To address this, I would like to propose laying 3–4 tons of hardcore along the main track to improve accessibility. As a club, we are more than willing to handle the labor required to spread it; however, I feel the cost of the materials should not fall solely on us.

Would the parish council be willing to cover the cost of the hardcore? This would ensure the parking area remains functional and continues to support the local community and our activities.

I believe we've made good progress with the parking situation so far, and this small investment would help maintain that.

The area has been inspected with Facilities and it is clear that the wet mud is pushing through the mats, making them sink/slimy and cars are losing grip. We are looking at different options to achieve an improved parking facility in all weather conditions but hardcore appears to be the best option for a semi-permanent/permanent solution (subject to budget)
