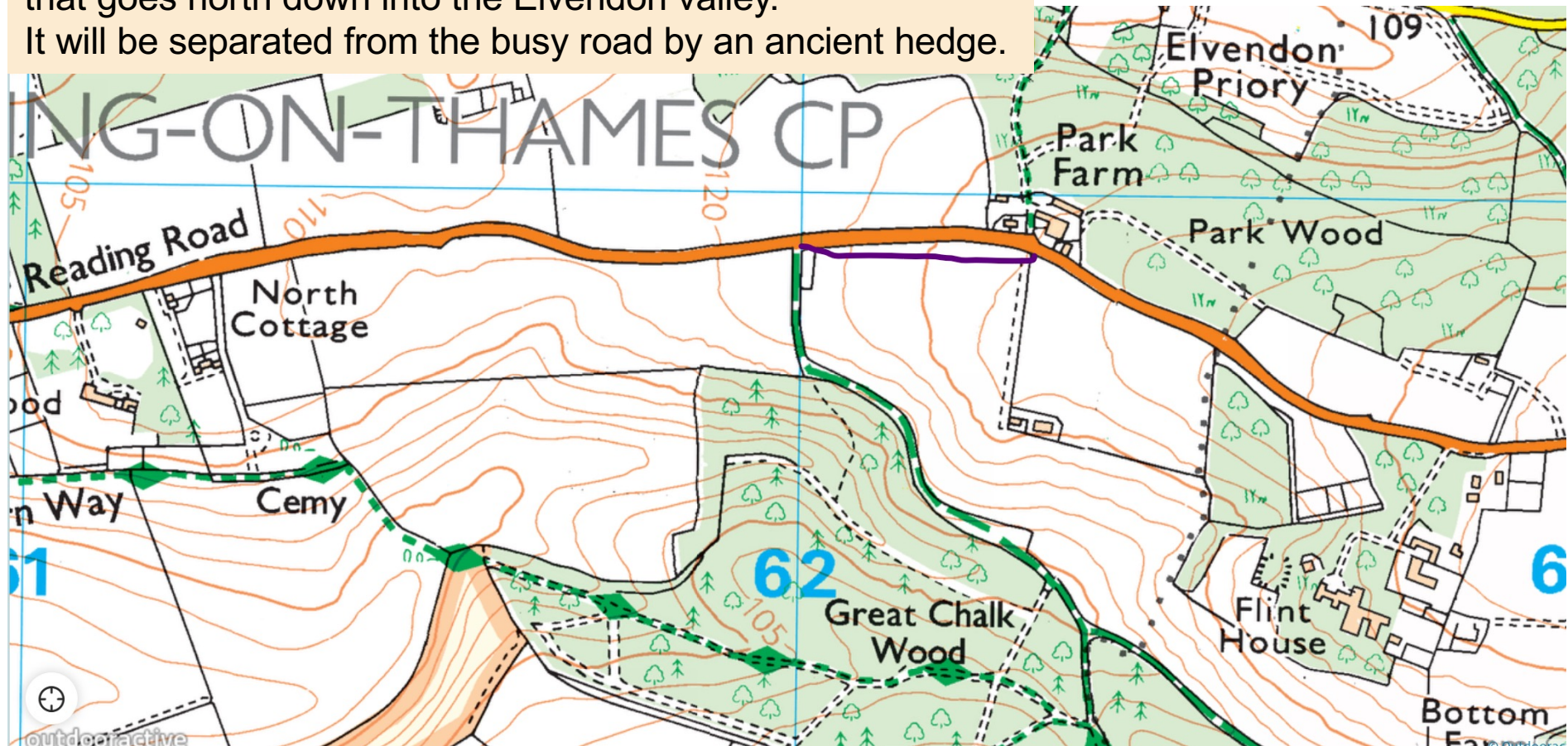


A new permissive path alongside the Reading Road

The new path will connect the bridleway that comes up from Great Chalk Wood to the footpath that goes north down into the Elvendon valley. It will be separated from the busy road by an ancient hedge.

Plan so far

- Approval for plans and budget for signs and clearance work – Feb TT committee
- Design / purchase small sign boards + “permissive” way mark signs – by end Feb 2025
- Need a work team to clear the ground – by end March 2025
- Put in posts and install signs – by end March 2025
- Publicity in GGN, Genie, Henley Standard, etc – April 2025
- Contact potentially interested parties – April 2025
- Commission / design new walking routes map showing this path – May 2025
- Inform OCC, SODC, Ordnance Survey, and anyone else who might be interested – May 2025
