

Notice of a Meeting of the Playgrounds Committee of the Goring-on-Thames Parish Council

Friday 7th November 2025 at 11.00am, Council Office, Old School

All Councillors who are members of the committee are summoned to attend the meeting.

Members of the public and press are invited to attend all meetings of the Council and its committees. (Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings) Act 1960)

Prior to the start of the meeting, questions and comments from members of the public (limited to 10 minutes in total).

This provides an opportunity for members of the public (who are not usually permitted to speak during the meeting except by special invitation of the Chairman) to participate before the start of the meeting. Members of the public may make only one address to the council of no more than three minutes' duration and only concerning topics on the agenda. No decision can be taken during this session, but the Chairman may decide to refer any matters raised for further consideration.
