### **Report from the Travel and Transport Committee Feb 26**

We are aware that residents are concerned about parking - Lockstile Mead has been identified by MOP as a concern. We are asking the OCC Highways Engagement Team to look at Lockstile on their next visit.

We are aware the surface of the path that runs across Bourdillon is poor. Again, we are looking for a response from OCC about options for dealing with this path. We have a lovely new playground, but the access to it from both sides is poor. We are continuing to explore the implications of redesignating this path as shared use.

The speed survey provided useful data which we aim to have published on the website for open access. It is planned to be a consistent, yearly data grab in order to build up concrete evidence of traffic patterns in the village over time. The Committee has put Neighbourhood Watch Speed awareness signs up in strategic locations across the village.

We are pleased that, after communicating with Cllr Gant at OCC, a traffic warden was seen patrolling the village. We continue to engage with the parking enforcement team.

The Ferry Lane accessible path has a preferred supplier, identified by a working group of the T and T committee. We have submitted a grant application to Mend the Gap for the full cost of the project and await their response.
